Each year, more than 600 bills are introduced and debated in the Colorado Legislature.

Generally speaking, the vast majority gets a quick thumbs up or thumbs down in Committee.

This generally helps those who follow along with the legislative process to narrow our focus and track only the bills which might one day become law, or the controversial bills which put our representatives on record for their votes.

But SB23-38 didn't seem to follow those unspoken rules, so a bill which would have banned the slaughter of horses for consumption made it through multiple readings, passed committee and ultimately... on the Senate floor last Thursday.

Here's the kicker...

This bill sought to solve a problem which doesn't exist in Colorado, or anywhere else in the United States for that matter. In fact, the last slaughterhouse which handled horses (in TX), closed their doors more than 15 years ago.

While other countries may still engage in this activity, a Colorado State law would have no bearing on their activities.

The bottom line is this bill took valuable time and resources to be discussed and voted upon, and regardless of whether it had passed or not, would have accomplished nothing whatsoever.

And while everyone testifying for or against this bill was distracted, both chambers of the Legislature passed anti-Second Amendment bills last week!

Still After The 2nd

Our newsletters have placed a lot of emphasis on the package of anti-Second Amendment bills this session, and will continue to do so as long as they loom in the Legislature.

They are:

SB23-168 - Allowing gun manufacturers and stores to be sued.

SB23-169 - Increasing minimum age to purchase a firearm to 21.

SB23-170 -Expansion of the "Red Flag" law.

HB23-1219 - Three day waiting period to purchase a firearm.

All four of these bills passed their original chamber, and have been referred to the House or Senate for additional committee hearings there.

Together, we must continue to make our voices heard in Denver!
